THE PROBLEM OF HURRY

JESUS' UNHURRIED LIFE, MINISTRY & MESSAGE

LIFE: Taking Time to Begin Well (*Luke 4:1-12*)

The evil one tempts us to hurry ahead of God's provision.

The evil one tempts us to hurry ahead of God-given authority and God-given honor.

The evil one tempts us to rush to make a name for ourselves, rather than receive the name He has given us.

MINISTRY: Taking Time to Gain Holy Perspective

Jesus makes a choice seasoned in unhurried communion with His Father, enriched in divine wisdom rather than trapped in conventional wisdom.

MESSAGE: Taking Time to Listen

UNHURRYING OUR LIVES

Rise early enough to linger a bit with God, rather than rush into whatever meetings and tasks the day holds.

Drive a little slower. Walk a little slower. Take a deep breath. Stop and really look at the one with whom you are talking. Do what Jesus said in Matthew 6 – "Look at birds. Notice flowers."
